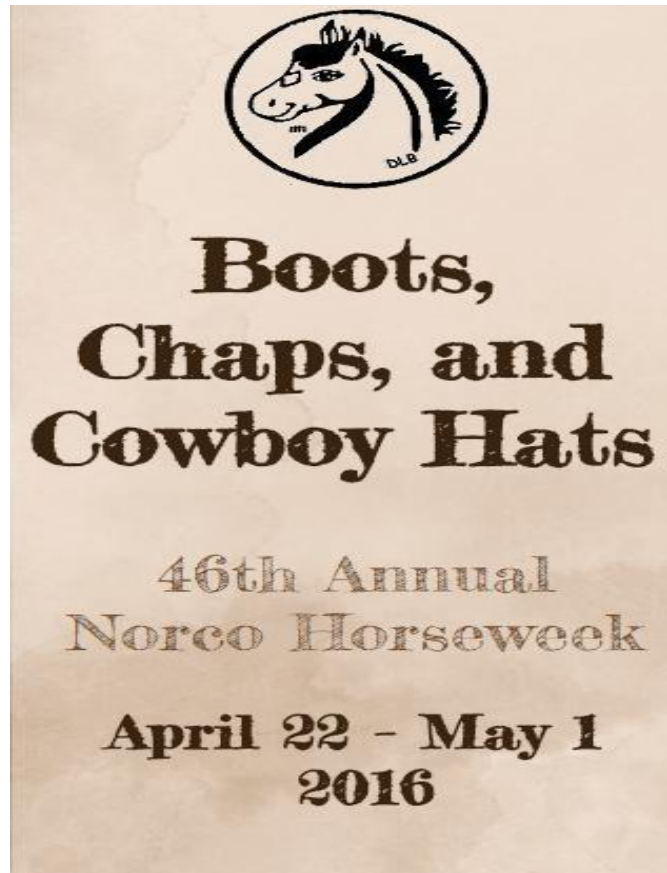

The meeting was called to order. Welcoming members and guests by President Pat Overstreet, to 6th Street Deli.

### **Old Business:**

- Still need volunteers for the Horseweek Rodeo: 2 Friday night ticket takers on the front gate and 1 ticket seller on Sunday. Personal schedules have been mailed.
- Horseweek Committee members are dwindling. Horseweek needs food platters/plates for their "1/4 Dip" night. Contact any Horseweek committee members if you can donate food items. Preferably items easy to serve in small cup-sized containers. (macaroni and cheese; chopped up spaghetti; casseroles; whatever you can think of to help.)

### **New Business:**

- Horseweek, Norco Fair, Ranch Tour and Posse Rodeo are all in their planning stages with meetings almost every day of the week. Be a volunteer and get involved. You will have fun and help the community too. (Check the web sites for specific dates and activities that are scheduled.) Faithful volunteers will be probably receiving their phone calls very soon!
- Lake Norconian Foundation actively needing monies to help protect the artifacts within. Linda Dixon and Sue Bacon talked about the Norconian Hotel and how the lawsuit in going to help fix the roof and protect the artifacts inside. The foundation has received permission from the court to move some of the items and be stored somewhere safe and secure. They need warehouse space. More info to come.
- Traffic Study workshop conducted for Crestview and California Streets 3/23/16. Almost 24,000 cars travel to and from that area due to morning and evening commuter traffic.
- More double left-hand turn lanes for Norco are coming, due to the increase of traffic.
- Ck. out the information via your computer, from the City Clerk's Office. Keeps you in the loop about City happenings. **\*\* Especially plan on attending March 31st, the Norco State of the City, by Mayor Kevin Bash at Nellie Weaver Hall.\*\***
- **June 11th**, Scheduled 5k walk/run/ride for the Norconian (ck. their website for time and particulars). Councilman Newton will handle the logistics involving this activity and Councilman Hoffman will be the breakfast cook.
- **March 29th**, Vietnam Veterans Memorial Celebration schedule for George Ingalls Memorial Park at 8:30 am, all invited and encouraged to attend.

**Guest Speaker:** The Lansing Company (owners and developers of the Wyle Lab. property) Speakers: Adam Eventov and Rick Hoffman who represent the above owner.

- 430 acres for development will be called the Canyon Creek Resort hopefully to consist of hotel(s); parking lots to accommodate; a restaurant(s). Easy access to the golf course.
