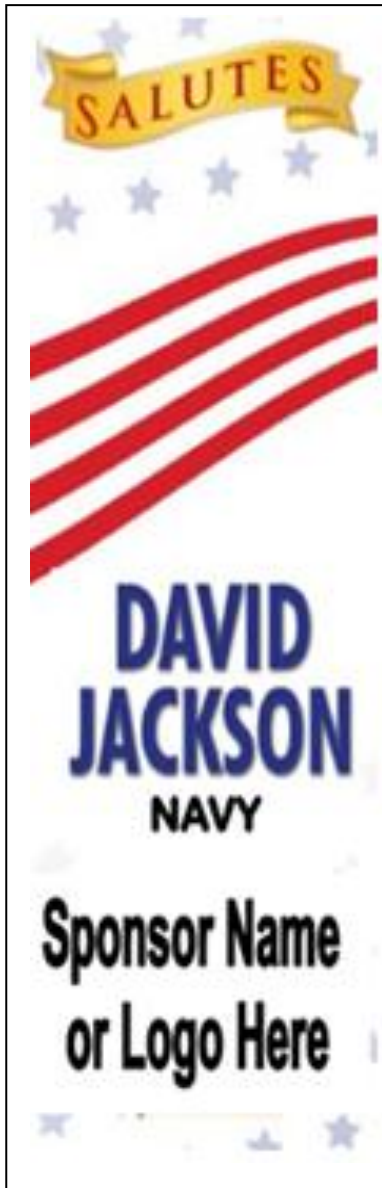

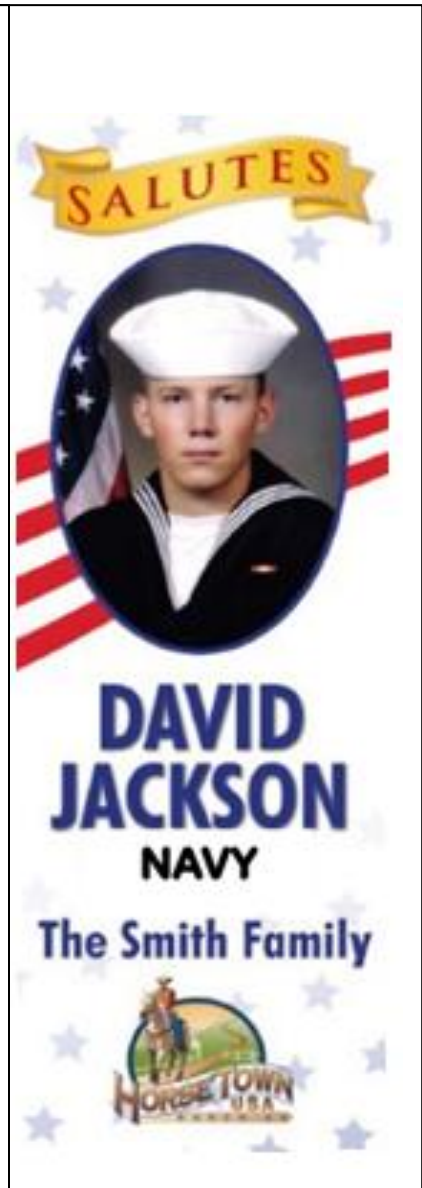


PATRIOTIC BANNERS

Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC)
Announces Meetings & Membership for Wyle Labs Community Advisory Group

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is overseeing the investigation and proposed cleanup activities at the Wyle Labs Facility located at 1841 Hillside Avenue, Norco, California. This notice is to provide you with information about the Community Advisory Group (CAG) which formed to review and provide community input to investigation and the proposed cleanup of contamination at Wyle.

In August of 2003, DTSC received a petition from Norco community members asking for our assistance to form a CAG. Section 25358.7.1 of the California Health and Safety Code, directs us to assist a group in the formation of a CAG. In October of 2003, we appointed seven initial CAG members who appointed additional members.

CAG Meetings

The Wyle Labs CAG typically holds their meetings on the 3rd Thursday of each month at the City Council Chambers. The meetings begin at 7:00 p.m. and members typically discuss updates on the Wyle Labs investigation and in some instances, presentations from government agencies may be given.

Based on the statute cited above, the CAG will review the response action (investigation and cleanup activities) at the Wyle Labs and DTSC will regularly communicate, and confer as appropriate, with the CAG. The mission statement developed by the CAG states "The mission of the Wyle Community Advisory Group is to ensure that the public is informed and involved early in the assessment of on- and off-site contamination, along with health risks; that their issues and concerns are heard; and that their comments are considered by the Department of Toxic Substance Control staff and management in their decision making during this process."
