Treasurer report by Denise Lynn Sutherland. Income for September = \$125 in Membership renewals & \$120 in annual advertising = total income \$245 & expenses of \$120.00 Annual Business Express Mail box and \$58.32 for AFS Printing for June & August 2016 Newsletters. = Balance \$8,764.40, minus \$3,400 for trail markers, to be managed by Don Kramer, leaving \$5,364.40 in the General Fund, as of 10/27/16.

Remember, Shop Norco!!!

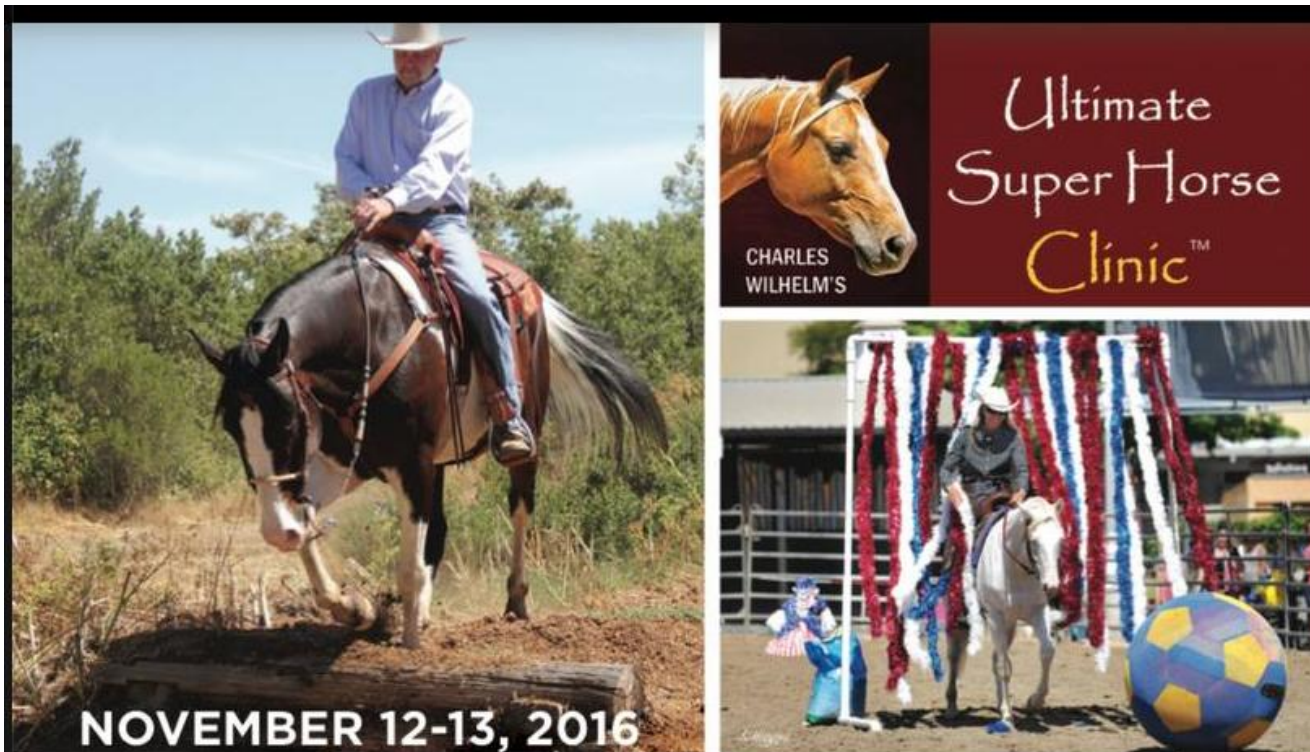
